









- WHAT IS A US TAG?
 - It is a body of "experts" in related fields that create, review, comment, propose changes, make improvements to a evolving "standard" in that field.
- WHAT IS A US TAG TA? (Technical Advisor)
 - It is a person who advises and administrates to the US TAG
 - Sends out notices of impending votes, collects responses and forms a US position
 - Votes the US position for TC 82

- SO WHY HAVEN'T WE HEARD FROM THE US TAG BEFORE THIS?
 - Function of US TAG Technical Advisor slowed and became vacant.
 - Occasionally IEC TC 82 work was not voted on.
 - Co-ordination between standards groups was infrequent or not accomplished

HOW DO I JOIN IF I WISH TO DO SO?

- 1st join ANSI, (as of today the dues are \$285.00 a year).
- 2nd, determine what interest group you would like to be copied on and send to me.



 3td, determine if you want to participate as a US representative in the working groups. IF SO, please send a brief resume of accomplishments in your field, to be forwarded to the Convenor of the WG. The Convenor determines how many participants and skills are necessary to balance his / her group. Commit to attend two weeks a year (spring & fall), & pay your expenses for travel, meals, hotels etc. Meetings will be held in any member country. Write standards, discuss and form consensus in the working groups.






US TAG "Update"

- In order to accomplish these objectives I will need help!











